



2023-2024 JPII ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS UNIFORM POLICY – GRADES PRE-K – 5.

The purpose of the JPII Catholic Schools uniform policy is to provide a learning environment that supports the mission of JPII Catholic Schools. A school uniform helps limit external distractions to learning and encourages positive student behavior and modesty while providing a safe, disciplined learning environment for all students. A school uniform lessens the impact of socioeconomic differences when options are from the same vendor and helps students to experience a greater feeling of school identity and belonging.

General Information: Upon entering the school building, all students will follow the uniform policy until the end of the school day and if needed through afterschool programs. Students who are not following the uniform policy will be asked to conform or sent to the school principal for appropriate action, which may include calling home for a change of clothes or borrowing uniform clothes from the office. **Deacon Den apparel is not uniform approved.**

Uniform Items from Global School Wear with JPII Logo

- Short or long sleeve polo shirts Navy, red, or white
- Short or long sleeve oxford shirts..... White
- Sweaters and sweatshirt Red (with uniform shirt under)
- Fleece, full or ½ zip, jacket..... Black or red (with uniform shirt under)
- Skirts or skort..... Navy plaid (tights or leggings required Dec-Feb)
- Polo dresses and Jumpers Red, Navy, or Navy plaid (tights or leggings required Dec-Feb)

Other Uniform Items From Any Vendor

- Pants..... Khaki or navy–Must be Docker Style
- Shorts..... Khaki or navy–Must be Docker Style (No Shorts Dec-Feb)

Notes for Shirts

- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- White tee shirts may be worn under polo or oxford style shirts (no logos or emblems visible)

Notes for Pants & Shorts

- Pants/shorts must be Docker style
- Pants are not to be form-fitting and must have a finished hem, no rips, holes, or tears
- No jean style, yoke stitching, or rivets on the pants, as appears on jeans or colored jeans
- Shorts are not to fall below the knee and not more than 4" above the knee. No shorts Dec-Feb

Notes for Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers or Polo Dress

- Leggings or tights are to be black, navy, red or white. SOLID ONLY NO patterns allowed. Tights or leggings required Dec-Feb.
- Must wear uniform top under jumper
- Girls should wear shorts under their skirts, jumper, or dress that do not show and are black or navy only.
- Skirts, jumpers, or polo dresses must be worn no more than 4" above the knee.



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Clarifications about Clothing and Appearance

- **Shoes, Sandals, and Socks:** Plain solid socks: black, navy, red, or white, with no visible branding, must be worn with all shoes or sandals. Footwear must be secure on feet.
- **Accessories:** Accessories may be worn as long as they do not distract from the uniform or be distracting to others.
- **Hair:** Hair must be of natural color.
- **Non-Uniform Day:** Non-uniform days will be designated on the monthly school calendar. Students are to wear clothing appropriate for the school environment on those days.
